POLICY STATEMENT – RoHS Issue 3 – 1st August 2019

Supply of parts that comply with:

RoHS (Restrictions of use of certain Hazard Substances)

- EU Directive 2002/95/ER
- EU Directive 2011/65/EU RoHS 2 plus EU 2015/863 (RoHS 3) which provides an amendment to Annex II of RoHS (2011/65/EU) and confirms the inclusion of four new restricted substances.

In August 2005 Challenge (Europe) Limited recognised the need to initiate practices that would enable us to meet in full the requirements of the initial EU Directive 2002/95/ER and any subsequent revisions.

To the best of our knowledge and beliefs we are able to advise that those of our products impacted by the current regulations are fully compliant, either by virtue of the total elimination of the restricted substances or by meeting the allowable limits as detailed below.

Cadmium and its compounds	100 ppm (0.01 weight %)
Mercury and its compounds	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Hexavalent Chromium and its compounds	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Lead and its compounds	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB)	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE)	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Bis(2-ethylhexyl) Phthalate (DEHP)	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Butyl Benzyl Phthalate (BBP)	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Dibutyl Phthalate (DBP)	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)
Diisobutyl Phthalate (DIBP)	1000 ppm (0.1 weight %)

Challenge will continue its practices to monitor for and comply with any further revisions to the EU Directives, regardless of the outcome of Brexit negotiations. In addition, we will continue to advise our customers on the impact any future revisions may have on product specification changes or availability.
